- Bone Stock Consolation Showdown (10 laps back half of qualifiers starting straight up)
- Bone Stock Quick Qualifier Dash (10 laps front half of qualifiers starting straight up)
- Best Appearing Voting for Demolition Derby (cars to front straightaway, voting done by audience vote
- Bone Stock FEATURE (50 laps Starting lineup based on heats Dash determines inside line, Showdown determines outside line)
- Intermission (20 mins Pumpkins to be smashed on race track at this time, cars to infield)
- Bone Stock FEATURE (50 laps lined up inverted from finishing order of first feature)
- **Demolition Derby** (On front straightaway towards turn 1) Car barriers rolled in place and track wet down. only derby officials & safety crew allowed along main wall. Spectators must stay back. At end there will be a trophy ceremony in derby arena.

Notes:

- Each feature race pays full championship points (1st 50, 2nd 49, etc)
- Qualifying pays championship points (1st 5, 2nd 4, etc)
- Nightly payouts are based on average of two features
- Showdown and Dash pay no championship points and does not contribute to nightly average
